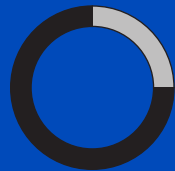
A United Way led initiative

An educated young work force is critical to the future success of our city. We must ensure youth complete high school and go on to acquire the education, skills and training they need to be workforce-ready.

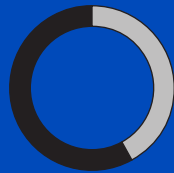
This is where United Way's "All In" for Youth initiative comes in.

Many Alberta youth are disconnected from school.



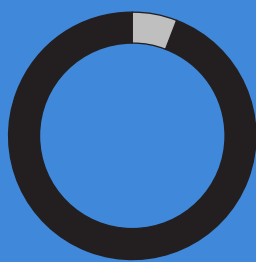
25% of Calgary youth don't finish school on time.

We need to reconnect youth and inspire them to stay in or return to school

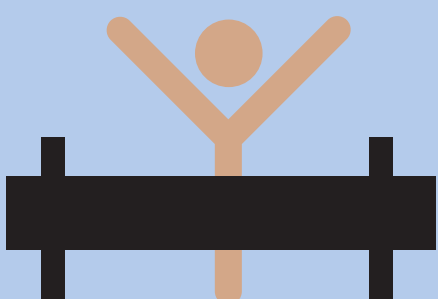
6% of jobs are open to individuals with no high school diploma.
